Subj: COMMAND POLICY ON ENVIRONMENTAL COMPLIANCE

1. Naval Construction Battalion Center (NCBC) Gulfport is committed to environmental compliance with local, State, and Federal laws, regulations, and policies to ensure we are always a good steward of our environment. Environmental stewardship is essential to the safe, healthful, and compliant execution of our mission, and the preservation and protection of our land, air, water, and other natural resources.
