- 1. Naval Air Station Whiting Field (NASWF) recognizes that environmental excellence is essential to the success of our mission. My goal is to foster a culture of environmental protection, preservation, and conservation through active stewardship and advocacy for our unique natural resources. To achieve this, I ask everyone individually and collectively to prevent pollution and ensure compliance with environmental laws and regulations.
- 2. The following principles will guide our collective efforts:
- a. Evaluate existing practices and develop objectives, targets, and procedures that align with established goals and mitigate environmental impacts.
- b. Conduct annual base-wide environmental audits to ensure NASWF complies with state and federal environmental laws and regulations. These audits will also assess the effectiveness of the Environmental Management System (EMS) as a tool for continuous improvement.
- c. Communicate NASWF's Environmental Policy to all personnel and educate them on their roles and responsibilities as environmental stewards, in accordance with OPNAV Instruction M-5090.1. This will include environmental training during Cross-Functional Team Meetings and other training events.
- d. Raise community awareness of NASWF's environmental initiatives by utilizing the NASWF website and engaging in outreach activities such as Earth Day events.
- 3. My Environmental Department will take the lead in implementing these principles, but success will depend on the collective effort of the entire team.
