

# **SPILL RESPONSE INFORMATION**

## **EXTREMELY IMPORTANT**

**ONLY RAIN MAY ENTER THE STORM DRAIN.**  
KEEP ALL CHEMICALS AND SPILLS FROM ENTERING STORM  
DRAINS, BAYS, PONDS, & CRITICAL HABITAT.

## **WHAT TO DO**

**STEP 1 - IF MATERIAL SPILLED PRESENTS A POTENTIAL TO  
HARM HUMAN LIFE, EVACUATE THE AREA  
IMMEDIATELY. **CALL 911.****

**STEP 2 - SHUT OFF SOURCE OF SPILL, IF POSSIBLE.**

**STEP 3 - CONTAIN SPILL WITH PROPER ABSORBENTS  
IN ASSIGNED SPILL KITS.**

**STEP 4 - NOTIFY NASCC COMMAND DUTY OFFICER (CDO)

**STEP 5 - NOTIFY & SUBMIT SPILL REPORT WITH PHOTOS TO  
ENVIRONMENTAL **361-961-5353/3776/5355****

**Spillers are responsible for cleanup actions and costs.**

**All spills must be reported to Environmental, and a spill report  
must be submitted within 24 hours to Environmental.  
All staining and spill residuals must be photographed and explained.**
