MEALS AT THE JET PORT CAFÉ

- Reservations are required at least one **FULL** week in advance.
- Please email NASP Community Relations at Pensacolapao@gmail.com with your meal needs. The Public Affairs Office will initiate a request for galley access on the group’s behalf.
- Groups must arrive at least 30 minutes before meal time ends.
- Payment accepted – Organizational and personal major credit cards only. The galley is a cashless facility as of May 1, 2022.

Historic Lighthouse Pensacola

Pensacola Lighthouse & Museum offers climbing tours of the landmark 1859 lighthouse. The Richard C. Callaway Museum in the restored 1869 keeper's quarters offers local history exhibits including: Late Weeden Island culture, Presidio Santa Maria de Galve, first Pensacola Lighthouse and the villages of Warrington and Woolsey. Also available are a museum store, and programs include a free history lecture series, sunset tours, children's programs, weddings and special events. Fort Barrancas

High on a bluff overlooking the entrance to Pensacola Bay, Fort Barrancas stands as a monument to the legacy of America's early homeland defense. Built with 6 million bricks, walls 4 feet thick and 20 feet high, Fort Barrancas was completed in 1844 and remains an example of military engineering and a marvel of human ingenuity. Enjoy indoor exhibits about the history of the area and restrooms at the Fort Barrancas Visitor Center. The center is staffed by park rangers or volunteers.
