Subj: DOMESTIC VIOLENCE

1. **DOMESTIC VIOLENCE WILL NOT BE TOLERATED!** It often is a violation of the Uniform Code of Military Justice (UCMJ). Domestic violence is always a purposeful act. Violence is not acceptable at work; it is not acceptable at home.

- 2. We must do all we can to prevent domestic violence by providing General Military Training, supporting Sailors and family members who seek help early, and publicizing referral information for victims.
- 3. It is my responsibility to ensure victims of domestic violence (military and civilian) are safe and the allegations are promptly investigated by base security and/or Naval Criminal Investigative Service.
