Subj: DOMESTIC VIOLENCE

1. **DOMESTIC VIOLENCE WILL NOT BE TOLERATED!** It often is a violation of the Uniform Code of Military Justice (UCMJ). Domestic violence is always a purposeful act. Violence is not acceptable at work; it is not acceptable at home.
2. We must do all we can to prevent domestic violence by providing General Military Training, supporting Sailors and family members who seek help early, and publicizing referral information for victims.
3. It is my responsibility to ensure victims of domestic violence (military and civilian) are safe and the allegations are promptly investigated by base security and/or Naval Criminal Investigative Service.
