Commanding Officer's Policy 7-24

Subj: ENVIRONMENTAL

Ref: (a) Executive Order 13693

1. U.S. Naval Station, Guantanamo Bay, Cuba (NSGB) enables the United States to maintain port and airfield facilities in support of military and humanitarian operations throughout the Caribbean Sea and the SOUTHCOM Area of Responsibility. Environmental conservation and facilities preparedness are key to the overall mission readiness of the installation.

2. Responsible maintenance of the installation environmental resources while supporting military training, readiness, and quality of life for residents is one of my major priorities. All personnel shall:

- a. Comply with all applicable environmental regulations.
- b. Conform to the NSGB Environmental Management System.
- c. Commit to pollution prevention.
- d. Identify opportunities for pollution prevention.
- e. Incorporate environmental considerations in the decision-making process.

3. Tenant and subordinate commanders are requested to communicate this policy to their staff and emphasize awareness of this Environmental Policy.
